Ausdance VIC supports and encourages respectful conversation about dance education, careers, training, performance, opportunities and ideas on our accounts.

Comment moderation policy:

We actively seek engagement from the dance sector and encourage comments, questions and feedback but expect everyone to behave in a respectful manner.

Please be thoughtful and respectful when commenting and interacting on Ausdance VIC social media accounts.

The following types of comments are not tolerated by Ausdance VIC:

1. Comments that are malicious, obscene, racist, sexist, defamatory, off-topic, or spam;
2. Demeaning remarks about personal appearance, ability, age, gender identity, sexual orientation, religion, ethnic origin or race;
3. Harassment, bullying, profanity, threatening language, attacks on or intimidation of our online community members or Ausdance VIC staff;
4. Comments that Ausdance VIC believes could infringe on any person's intellectual property rights, copyright, or content that is unlawful in any way;
5. Comments that suggest or encourage illegal activities;
6. Comments that are promotional or commercial in nature, or solicit donations.

Comment removal is at the discretion of Ausdance VIC.

We try to respond to comments and questions within 24 hours but as Ausdance VIC staff all work part-time it may take longer.
